MINUTES

Mayor Funk opened the meeting at 5:30 p.m. and informed the audience this was a listening session with a quorum of the Council present. There will be no discussion nor decision made by the Council. It is to gather input of resident concerns regarding the proposed Marsh Lake Road improvement project.

Staff Present: City Manager Dana Hardie, City Engineer Cara Geheren

City Manager Dana Hardie introduced the format of the Neighborhood Meeting to discuss the Marsh Lake Road Improvements the Project. Residents provided input and feedback on Project. Residents expressed opposition for the 55 mph, 2-lane divided roadway the City is considering as a partnership with Carver County.

The residents discussed improvements for Marsh Lake Road they would like Council to consider which reflect a two-lane undivided roadway without curb and gutter and without a trail. Residents further expressed safety concerns as it relates to alignments and speed limits. They discussed the desire for lower speed limits, and potential realignment in limited areas to enhance safety. Other items discussed included the residents' desire to pursue a project that has the least environmental impact, to keep the hills/valleys (topography), that is unique to the area, and to keep the roadway width that exists today.


ADJOURNMENT
