ORDINANCE NO. 426

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2 OF
THE VICTORIA CITY CODE REGARDING CITY
COUNCIL-MANAGER FORM OF GOVERNMENT**

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, CARVER COUNTY,
MINNESOTA, ORDAINS:**

SECTION 1. Chapter 2, Article IV, Division 4, Section 2-160 of the Code of Ordinances, City of Victoria, Minnesota, is hereby amended by deleting the ~~stricken~~ language as follows:

Sec. 2-160. - Limitations of authority.

(a) The manager shall not have supervision or authority over the office of the city attorney, or any boards, committees or commissions created by ordinance or by appointment by the mayor or council, ~~or the fire department, except in budgetary matters,~~ or over matters within the strict legal jurisdiction of a civil service commission or a union representing city employees.


(b) The authority and duties of the manager are not intended to, and do not, include the performance of any act violating any city ordinances, council rules, laws and official regulations of the state or laws and official regulations of the United States of America.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication in accordance with the law.
