

MARSH LAKE ROAD

Status update: April 29, 2019



Activities from the week of April 22nd

- A kick off meeting was held with Public Works on Tuesday, April 23rd. Public works will be completing a site visit today to review the existing roadway and identify areas with maintenance challenges pertaining to the roadway, shoulders, side slopes and drainage, etc. Several topics were raised at the meeting that will require future consideration if the Council moves forward with Option 3 such as gravel versus seed mixture for shouldering, driveway aprons (1-foot to 5-feet), radius and width for Hunt Club apron and striping of the roadway.
- A meeting has been scheduled with the State Aid Office on Tuesday, April 30th to review the ability to use state aid funds for Option 2 and Option 3.
- The City attorney has reviewed the existing alignment at the intersection of Lakeside Drive and Marsh Lake Road and has concluded that the City is not legally obligated to realign the road in this area. Even though not legally obligated, staff will continue to evaluate realigning in this area.
- The construction plans for the Halstead Lane and the Airport Road projects have been posted to the website.
- The 2014 geotechnical evaluation report has been posted to the website.
- Input is welcome on the draft list of decision matrix parameters.
